DID YOU KNOW?

You can have an STI even if you've only had one partner, and most people with an STI are **asymptomatic** (experiencing no symptoms)!

**CONSENT ROC(K)S****R: Reciprocal, Respectful, Right of Refusal**

- Consent is given by both parties freely without pressure or manipulation. All parties feel comfortable saying no.

O: Ongoing

- Consent can be changed at any time, even if you've already started an activity.

C: Clear

- Consent is given after understanding the boundaries and parameters of the activity, and consent is given for a specific activity (and not generalized to other activities).

S: Straightforward

- Consent is not given under pressure or after being worn down.

Using alcohol to get another person incapacitated or make it easier to pressure them into sexual activity is *sexual assault*.

Ask yourself:

- *Can this person communicate clearly?*
- *Are they coherent?*
- *Would they refuse or not want to do this if they were sober?*
- *Are they cognizant to know fully what is going on?*
- *Will this be a fully enjoyed experience for both parties that we will not regret later?*
